 - Mediterranean Ave culverts, work starting this week by PW crews
 - Route 97 sidewalks, block grant approved should begin construction in the spring of 2017
 - Nordon Village, paving to begin this week

5. NEW BUSINESS: Norwichtown Green Liberty Pole


After some discussion, this item was tabled to the August PWC meeting.
