WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norwich approved a 2010-11 Capital Budget for the Norwich Fire Department in the amount of \$136,781 for the purpose of replacing 16 air packs, 12 sets of turnout gear, radio equipment for the ladder truck, the Plain Hill Tower radio, three low-band portable radios, 15 meters, and four Level A Hazmat suits; and

WHEREAS, the Norwich Fire Department deems the replacement of a thermal imaging camera to be more of an immediate need than the four Level A Hazmat suits; and

WHEREAS, the Norwich Fire Department would like to apply \$5,180 of its \$136,781 Capital Budget which had been allocated for Level A Hazmat suits towards the replacement of a thermal imaging camera.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH, that the 2010-11 Capital Budget for the Norwich Fire Department be amended to delete the four Level A Hazmat suits and add the partial funding for replacement of a thermal imaging camera.
