**WHEREAS**, the Norwich City Council finds that the proposed Rehabilitation of the Sherman Street bridges over the Yantic River is in the best interest of the City of Norwich, and will promote the health, safety and general welfare of its residents and provide for convenience and safety of the motoring and walking public.
