WHEREAS, the Health Equity Index (HEI) is a tool that can be used to engage community members and leaders to address health inequities identified in social, political, and environmental conditions in Norwich, and

WHEREAS, the Uncas Health District is one of seventeen health departments throughout the state to apply for funds to support the project, and

WHEREAS, there are funds available through the Connecticut Association of Directors of Health for the Uncas Health District to utilize the tool and identify innovative approaches to address the root causes of inequities, and

WHEREAS, the Uncas Health District is eligible to receive up to \$150,000 each year from June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, no matching funds will be required from the City of Norwich,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Norwich City Council, that the City Manager Alan H. Bergren is authorized to sign of statement of commitment authorizing the Uncas Health District to apply for grant funds available through the Connecticut Association of Directors of Health.
