**WHEREAS**, these donations shall be made payable to the City of Norwich and will be deposited into the City of Norwich Human Services Grants & Programs Fund account S3312-75000; and

**WHEREAS**, the donations and expenditures of those donations would be required to follow all of the laws, policies and procedures of the City of Norwich including, but not limited to accounting, purchasing, risk management, and cash handling; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH**, that the Human Services Department be authorized to expend those donations raised for the purpose of helping the individuals affected by the March 2010 flooding from Human Services Grants & Programs Fund account S3312-80000; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, should the donations exceed the expenditures required to help the individuals affected by the March 2010 flooding, any excess will remain in the City of Norwich Human Services Grants & Programs Fund to be used for any future Norwich disaster relief assistance.

**WHEREAS**, The City of Norwich has been affected by recent severe flooding, and;

**WHEREAS**, Norwich Human Services has been working with low-income residents who have been facing financial hardship as a result of the flooding, and;

**WHEREAS**, in the event that flood relief is provided to flood victims through State, FEMA or Insurance funds, these funds will be requested to be used to reimburse the City of Norwich for assistance given on behalf of the recipient, and;

**WHEREAS**, Flood Relief Funds will be held for a period of six months, at which time any remaining funds will be returned to the City of Norwich.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the sum of \$10,000 be and hereby is appropriated from contingency account 01090-80086 and that the City Manager, Alan H. Bergren, be and hereby is authorized to set up a Flood Relief Fund in the amount of \$10,000 through Norwich Human Services for the purpose of providing emergency transition assistance to low-income flood victims.
