

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF A FEE FOR REQUIRED
DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE REPORTING**

WHEREAS, the City of Norwich is required pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 14-33(a) to notify the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles if a taxpayer is delinquent in the payment of a property tax or installment thereof on any motor vehicle or snowmobile;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 7-148(c) and Connecticut General Statute Section 12-166, the Town is empowered to collect taxes and regulate the mode and assessment of the collection of taxes including interest, penalties, fees, and charges; and

WHEREAS, The City of Norwich spends considerable time and expense in complying with the aforementioned statutes.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORWICH, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE HEREBY IS ADOPTED BY THE
CITY OF NORWICH:**

Section I.

1. TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING COLLECTION OF A FEE FOR DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE REPORTING.

2. Each taxpayer who has been or who becomes delinquent in the payment of any property tax or installment thereof on a motor vehicle or snowmobile and whose delinquency has been reported to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 14-33, in addition to the delinquent taxes and all interest thereon, costs and other fees shall pay to the tax collector a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) for each such reported delinquency.

Section II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. If any provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of any other part of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications; and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance and the various applications thereof are declared to be severable.

Section IV. This ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day following its passage and publication as prescribed in Chapter V, Section 10 of the Norwich City Charter.
