- a. *New course tee-off and basket proposal* - Kyle Seitz made the motion to move forward with the existing plan/map (see attached) to install a 9 hole disc golf course in and around the area of the pavilion on Mohegan Park Rd. Beryl Fishbone 2nd the motion.

Kyle Seitz mentioned that we are hopefully moving forward with the purchase of 11 baskets. One is earmarked for park center off of a paved path and another one could be place in the area of the field for easier access to a wider range of participants.
